## Celebrating 10 Years of Impact!

Engineering Ministries International  
Canada has been mobilizing Canadian  
architects, engineers and surveyors for 10  
years now – and this year we're  
celebrating the impact that these design  
professionals are having on the kingdom  
of God throughout the world!

Canadian design professionals have served on  
over 150 different eMi projects – some led out  
of the Canada office, and some led by our  
partner offices worldwide. Their surveying,  
architecture, engineering, and drafting skills  
have made an impact:

The eMi-designed ROTOM Health Center  
in Uganda hosted an eye clinic for seniors –  
even before the doors were installed or the  
walls plastered.

The eMi-designed Transition House in  
Cambodia provided a home for Kosol Eik Chan  
– the first Place of Rescue orphan to graduate  
from High School – as he studied Information  
Technology at the University.

The eMi-designed Danja Fistula Centre in  
Niger has provided corrective surgery to more  
than 130 women like Fatsima, Mariamma and  
Aisha who suffered from Obstetric Fistula,  
giving them hope for a new life.

And even before the designs are drafted and  
the buildings are built, ministries share with us  
the impact of having a team of professionals  
come alongside them to listen to their vision –

to encourage them and to validate their  
ministry.

But our commitment is to enrich the lives of  
those who give as well as those who receive.  
And eMi has also been impacting the lives of  
our interns and volunteers as they see a role  
for themselves in building God's kingdom.  
Engineers and architects are learning that  
their skills and experience can be used for  
ministry, impacting the deepest needs of the  
world. Now, that's worth celebrating!
